FAQs

How does the programme work?

The programme is a mixture of online learning, applied work experience and block course learning. You will attend four 2 day block courses, unless you require rural vehicle unit standards and then one of the block courses will be for a total of four days.

What do I need to bring to block courses?

You will need to bring a pen and paper and covered shoes for the practical components. You will need to bring your lunch, tea and coffee will be provided.

What time will the block courses start/finish?

The block course days will start at 9am to allow for travel time. Each day will generally finish at 4pm.

What else do I need?

At home you will need an internet connection and a way to connect to the internet. You may find having a smartphone will help you to easily fulfil your assessment requirements.

How much does it cost?

The full price is \$1524 including GST. You may be eligible for a \$400 (inc. GST) rebate if you successfully complete the programme. You may be eligible for fees free if you meet the requirements of the government subsidy. If this is the case you will not be eligible for the rebate.
